By Ms. Dykema of Holliston, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3269) of Chris Walsh, and others relative to the control of low lands and swamps to control of tick-borne illness. Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to control of tick-borne illness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 252 as appearing in the 2008 General Laws, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the word “mosquitoes”, in line 4, the following words:- or ticks.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 4 the word “commissioner,”, in line 3, the following words:- 1 employee of the department of fish
- 5 and game designated by its commissioner.
- 6 SECTION 3. Said Section 2 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 7 striking out the words, “state reclamation and mosquito control board” in lines 5 and 6 and
- 8 inserting in place thereof the following words:- state reclamation, mosquito and tick control
- 9 board.
- 10 SECTION 4. Section 3 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 11 the first sentence the following two sentences:- The board may investigate integrated pest

12 management techniques for the protection of public health and the protection against tick-borne
13 disease. It may publish and disseminate facts of general interest ascertained in the conduct of
14 any such investigation including the financial and public health efficacy of the techniques, and
15 may make and publish surveys of tracts of land with high rates of tick-borne disease, showing
16 their situation and such other details as it deems advisable.

17 SECTION 5. Section 5A of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out
18 the words “Mosquito and Greenhead Fly Control Fund”, in line 15, in lines 75 and 76 and in line
19 94, and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the following words:- Mosquito, Greenhead
20 Fly and Tick Control Fund.

21 SECTION 6. Section 24 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out
22 the words “state reclamation board”, in line 1, and inserting in place thereof the following
23 words:- state reclamation, mosquito and tick control board.

24 SECTION 7. Chapter 252 is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

25 Section 25. Upon request of a city or town, the state reclamation, mosquito and tick control
26 board may implement integrated pest management techniques investigated as described in
27 section 3 for the protection of public health and the protection against tick-borne disease.

28 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect January 1, 2012.
