An Act relative to stipends for interns of the General Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9B of chapter 3 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Each member of the general court shall receive \$1,000 annually in order to provide a  
4 stipend to any intern serving in the member’s office; provided, however, that no member shall  
5 receive more than 1 stipend allocation annually; and provided further, that any portion of such  
6 stipend not disbursed to interns shall be returned to the state treasurer on or before July 1.
