## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act to eliminate the statute of limitations on all felony crimes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 277 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 63 and
- 2 inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 Section 63. An indictment for any felony crime may be found at any time after the date of the
- 4 commission of the offense.
