Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act exempting the positions of patrolman, seargent and the lieutenant in the police department of the town of Maynard from the civil service law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the positions of
2 patrolman, sergeant and lieutenant in the police department of the town of Maynard shall be
3 exempt from chapter 31 of the General Laws.

4 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall not impair the civil service status of a person serving as a
5 patrolman, sergeant or lieutenant for the police department of the town of Maynard on the
6 effective date of this act unless such person is subsequently promoted to a different position.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
