**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act protecting motorists and emergency personnel.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended in section 17 by
2 inserting after the words “construction area”, the following words: -, or in the lane adjacent to the
3 right lane if signs have been erected by the department of highways permitting the use of such
4 lane,
