An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Linda Kelley, an employee of the Department of Transportation..

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Transportation, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 department of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Linda Kelley, an employee of
- 3 the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
- 4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Linda Kelley. Whenever Linda Kelley
- 5 terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the
- 6 balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended sick leave bank. Sick leave

7	bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the	
8	s establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
