An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Mitch Dembowski, an employee of the Department of Developmental Services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the department  
2 of Developmental Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Mitch Dembowski, an employee  
3 of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 of more sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Mitch Dembowski. Whenever Mitch  
5 Dembowski terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
