Resolved, That the board of elementary and secondary education is hereby authorized and directed to conduct a study relative to the establishment of ages five to eighteen years old as

- 4 the period of compulsory school attendance in Massachusetts. Such study shall include, but not
- 5 be limited to, analyses of the impact of the altered requirements on student's readiness for
- 6 elementary school, and on high school completion, with due attention to the experience in other
- 7 states; and analyses of fiscal implications for the commonwealth and for school districts. Said
- 8 board shall report to the general court the results of its study, and any related recommendations,
- 9 by filing the same with the clerks of the Senate and of the House of Representatives on or before
- 10 December 31, 2013.
