## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to the special commission on ordinary and accidental disability pensions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 revived and continued by section 4 of chapter 435 of the acts of 2012 is hereby further revived

- 5 proposed legislation, if any, with the clerks of the house and senate, the chairs of the house and
