## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to equitable dental reimbursement rates for services provided to publicly aided patients.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of Chapter 118G of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding:
- 2 The executive office shall develop a plan to index the child and adult dental fee schedule to the
- 3 seventy fifth percentile of the most current American Dental Association Survey of Dental Fees
- 4 of General Practitioners by January 1, 2013. The plan, at a minimum, shall include all dental
- 5 services covered as of January 1, 2009.
