# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Thomas Mulvey, an employee of the Department of Housing and Community Developments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the department shall establish a sick leave bank for Thomas Mulvey, an employee of the Department of Housing and Community Developments. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Thomas Mulvey. Whenever Thomas Mulvey terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank established by this act, the balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to the department paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
