## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act validating the date of incorporation of the town of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the date of July
- 2 8, 1713 is hereby ratified and confirmed and declared the legal and valid date of incorporation of
- 3 the Town of Oxford.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
