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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act to examine the issue of funding excessive class size.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the foundation budget commission shall
- 2 examine the issue of funding additional classrooms and/or staff when class size exceeds local
- 3 limits and where there is not available classroom space.
