## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to the penalties for accessory after the murder of a minor child.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 274 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 4 the 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 4A. Whoever, after the commission of a murder committed on a victim who was
- 4 a minor child, harbors, conceals, maintains or assists the principal felon or accessory before the
- 5 fact, or gives such offender any other aid, knowing that he or she has committed a felony or has
- 6 been accessory thereto before the fact, with intent that he or she shall avoid or escape detention,
- 7 arrest, trial or punishment, shall be an accessory after the fact, be punished by imprisonment in
- 8 the state prison for not more than 20 years or by a fine of not more than \$10,000 dollars.
