AN ACT ESTABLISHING A YOUTH AWARENESS WEEK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following subsection:
- 3 ZZZZ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the third week in April as Youth Awareness
- 4 Week to inform and educate youths on the benefit and operation of government, public service institutions and the
- 5 electoral process. Appropriate state agencies and cities and towns shall establish programs designed to educate and
- 6 promote these objectives.
