**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to driver education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 54 after the word “vehicle,” the
3 following sentence:- which shall also include a module on the science related to the impairment
4 effects of marijuana.
