An act relative to funeral processions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (b) of section 14A of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (3) and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following paragraph:-
- 4 (3) A vehicle being operated in any funeral procession shall have its headlights and taillights
- 5 illuminated, and shall have a 12" x 12" purple placard, flag or other reasonably noticeable device
- 6 above the vehicle's roof-line, either on the roof itself or protruding from the vehicle's window on
- 7 a rod, to indicate that the vehicle is part of the funeral procession.
