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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**  
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An Act relative to community outreach procedure for retail marijuana establishment license applicants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 94G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (b), by striking clause 1 and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following:-

4 “the prospective marijuana establishment has submitted an application in compliance  
5 with regulations made by the commission; the applicant satisfies the requirements established by  
6 the commission; the applicant has held two community outreach meetings, one of which shall be  
7 held during normal business hours and one of which shall be held in the evening and the  
8 applicant must provide public notice at least 14 calendar days prior to each community outreach  
9 meeting; the applicant is in compliance with this chapter and the commission regulations  
10 published in 935 CMR 500; and the applicant has paid the required fee.”
