## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An act authorizing the town of Tyringham to continue the employment of Rainsford Morehouse, a member of the police department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Rainsford Morehouse,
- 2 a member of the police department of the town of Tyringham, may continue in such position
- 3 until August 6, 2015; provided, however, that Rainsford Morehouse is mentally and physically
- 4 capable of performing the duties of the position. If requested, Rainsford Morehouse shall, at his
- 5 own expense, be examined by an impartial physician designated by the town to determine his
- 6 capacity.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
