## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act Authorizing the Town of Wendell to Provide for Alternative Energy and Sanitation Systems.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 127A of chapter 111 of the General
- 2 Laws, or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Town of
- 3 Wendell is hereby authorized to adopt by-laws or rules and regulations to permit alternative
- 4 energy, heating and sanitation systems for use in owner-occupied residential dwelling units.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
