- 3 ; provided, however, that no examination by the registrar shall require a person to use a
- 4 vehicle that allows the examiner unobstructed access to the vehicle's parking brake or to
- 5 otherwise require that an examiner may make an emergency stop by using the examination
- 6 vehicle's parking brake.
