Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of part B of section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following
- 3 subparagraph:-
- 4 (16) An amount as described in section 62(a)(2)(D) of the Code for certain expenses of
- 5 elementary and secondary school teachers, only to the extent the amount is not otherwise
- 6 deducted under subparagraph (7).
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall be effective for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2012.
