In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the appointment of firefighters in the town of Plainville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 58A of Chapter 31 of the General
- 2 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Plainville may, at its
- 3 discretion, allow each applicant for the position of firefighter, to have his/her name certified for
- 4 original appointment to the position of Firefighter within the Town of Plainville provided he/she
- 5 has reached his/her nineteenth birthday; and further provided he/she has not reached his/her
- 6 sixty-fifth birthday on the date of the firefighter entrance examination covered under Chapter 31
- 7 of the General Laws.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
