Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 93A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

- 2 Section 12.(a) For the purposes of bringing an action pursuant to section 11 it shall be an
- 3 unfair and deceptive trade practice for a health insurance issuer doing business in the
- 4 commonwealth pursuant to the general laws or a pharmacy benefit manager to directly or
- 5 indirectly charge or hold a pharmacist or pharmacy responsible for any fee related to a claim: (i)
- 6 that is not apparent at the time of claim processing; (ii) that is not reported on the remittance
- 7 advice of an adjudicated claim; or (iii) after the initial claim is adjudicated.
- 8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "pharmacy benefit manager" means a person, other
- 9 than a pharmacy or pharmacist, who acts as an administrator in connection with pharmacy
- benefits or administers the (i) prescription drug, prescription device or pharmacist services or (ii)
- prescription drug and device and pharmacist services portion of a health benefit plan on behalf of
- plan sponsors as provided for in the general laws.
