An Act relative to section 1E of Chapter 90.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1E of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following  
3 paragraphs:-

4           Motorized scooters shall not be ridden on sidewalks (i) except when necessary in the  
5 interest of safety, or (ii) unless otherwise directed by local ordinance; provided, that a person  
6 operating a motorized scooter on the sidewalk shall yield the right of way to pedestrians and give  
7 an audible signal before overtaking and passing any pedestrian.

8           For the purposes of, without limitation, sections 13B, 24, 24½, 24D, 24E, 24G, 24L, and  
9 24N of chapter 90, a motorized scooter shall be deemed to be a motor vehicle.
