In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to certain affordable housing in the city of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 ORDERED: That a petition to the General Court, accompanied by a bill for a special

2 law relating to the City of Boston to be filed with an attested copy of this order be, and hereby is,

3 approved under Clause 1 of Section 8 of Article II, as amended, of the Articles of Amendment to

4 the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to the end that legislation be adopted

5 precisely as follows, except for clerical or editorial changes of form only:

# 7 AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- 8 IN THE CITY OF BOSTON
- 9 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,

10 and by the authority of the same, as follows:

11 SECTION 1. Construction and development activity related to redevelopment by the Boston Housing Authority of the federally-funded Whittier public housing project, or any part 12 thereof, shall not be subject to any general or special law related to the procurement and award of 13 contracts for the construction, reconstruction, installation, demolition, maintenance, or repair of 14 buildings by a public agency, but shall be subject to sections 26 to 27H, inclusive, of chapter 149 15 16 of the Generals Laws. Contracts for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, remodeling, or repair of any publicly owned public works that service this project and would otherwise be 17 subject to section 39M of chapter 30 of the General Laws shall be subject to said section 39M if 18 19 the redevelopment of the project is funded in part by state or federal government low-income housing tax credit, grant, or loan, or pursuant to the issuance of tax-exempt bonds authorized by 20 general law. A conveyance of the project, whether by leasehold or fee estate, to an urban 21 22 redevelopment corporation organized under chapter 121A of the General Laws or to a nonprofit state and federally tax-exempt corporation organized for the purpose of revitalizing the project, 23 shall be subject to chapter 30B of the General Laws to the extent that the project is conveyed to 24 an entity that is not owned, controlled, or managed by the Boston Housing Authority on the date 25 of the conveyance. 26

27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
