**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to roadway safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 89 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 A person using a non-motorized vehicle, which shall mean a non-motorized scooter,
4 bicycle, and small-wheeled transport such as roller blades, roller skates or a skateboard, who is
5 crossing the roadway in a marked crosswalk where traffic control signals are not in place or not
6 in operation, shall be considered a pedestrian for purposes of this section.
