An Act relative to Chapter 32, Section 91a waivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91A of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “commission”, in line 9, the following
3 words:-
4 ; provided, however, that the commission may waive such filing by a member, if said member
5 shall have been retired for more than 20 years, has not reported any earnings for the prior 10
6 years and signs an affidavit under the pains and penalties of perjury indicating that should he
7 realize any earned income in the future he will forthwith notify the commission of that fact and
8 again report under this section.
