An Act Naming A Certain Bridge In The Town Of Dalton..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bridge No. D-01-009 on Route 8 in the town of Dalton shall be designated and
2 known as the 2nd Lt. Michael J. Casey, Sr. Memorial Bridge, in the memory of 2nd Lt. Michael
3 J. Casey, Sr., U.S.M.C., who was killed in action in Vietnam.

4 SECTION 2. The department of highways shall erect suitable markers bearing said designation
5 in compliance with the standards of said department. The department of public works for the
6 town of Dalton shall be responsible for the maintenance of said markers.
