## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CUEING AND SUPERVISION IN THE PCA PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1: Section 12 of chapter one hundred and eighteen E as so appearing, is hereby amended  
2 in the first paragraph by inserting at the end thereof the following new sentence:-

3 “Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the division shall  
4 develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care attendant  
5 program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible for said  
6 program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more activities of  
7 daily living.”
