An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Paula Campbell, an employee of the Trial Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for Paula Campbell, an employee the  
3 trial court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
4 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Paula Campbell. Whenever Paula Campbell  
5 terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any  
6 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank. Sick  
7 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court.
