An Act authorizing the town of South Hadley to pay certain unpaid bills.

*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to Allow the town of South Hadley to pay certain unpaid bills , therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The Treasurer of the Town of South Hadley is hereby authorized to pay
- 2 Meadowbrook Golf for the management services provided to the Ledges Golf Course,
- 3 notwithstanding the failure of the Town to comply with the appropriate provisions of the law
- 4 relative to procurement and competitive bidding, or take any action relative thereto.
  
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
