An Act eliminating the preliminary election in the city of Revere in 2011.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be no
- 2 preliminary election in the City of Revere as otherwise required on September 13, 2011 for either
- 3 the office of school committee for a 2-year term or for the office of city council for a 2-year
- 4 term. All candidates whose nomination papers have been duly certified shall be deemed to have
- 5 been nominated, and their names shall appear on the general election ballot.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
