In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to continuing education requirements for any person holding a license as a real estate broker or salesman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 87XX1/2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following two sentences:-
- 3 The board may authorize any courses or programs for continuing education credit which
- 4 satisfy the provisions of this section. The board may adopt such rules and regulations as it deems
- 5 necessary for the continuing professional education required for renewal of licenses.
