**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the waiver of a certain provision of the Methuen home rule charter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1: Notwithstanding the provisions of the City Charter of the City of Methuen or
2 any general or special law to the contrary, a waiver of Article 2, Section 2-5 of the Methuen
3 Home Rule Charter is hereby approved for the specific and sole purpose of providing for the
4 eligibility of Sean Fountain, prior to the expiration of his term as City Councilor on December
5 31, 2007, to be appointed to the position of Permanent Intermitten Police Officer of the Methuen
6 Police Department.

7 Section 2: Said appointment is to be made by the Mayor, Stephen N. Zanni and submitted
8 to the City Council of the City of Methuen for its approval, forthwith.

9 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
