An Act authorizing the City known as the Town of Watertown to pay the funeral and burial expenses of firefighter Joseph Toscano.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 100G<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of chapter 41 of the  
2   General Laws or any other general or special act to the contrary, the City known as the Town of  
3   Watertown is hereby authorized to pay the reasonable expenses, not exceeding \$15,000.00, of  
4   the funeral and burial of firefighter Joseph Toscano who died while in the performance of his  
5   duties for the Town, and all related actions of the Town are hereby ratified, validated and  
6   confirmed.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
