Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15IIIIII the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 15JJJJJJ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the last
- 4 full week in April as Building Trades Opioids Awareness Week to promote awareness of the
- 5 dangers of opioids and substance misuse among workers in the building trades industry and
- 6 facilitate discussions and events to combat the opioid epidemic and promote mental health in the
- 7 commonwealth's building trades industry.
