AN ACT TO LIMIT LOSSES OF SUBCONTRACTORS IN PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
 amended by inserting after Section 29D the following section 29E:-
- 3 SECTION 29E. Any provision for or in connection with a contract or agreement for
- 4 construction, alteration, repair or maintenance of a building, structure, or other improvement to
- 5 real property, including moving, demolition and excavating connected therewith, purporting to
- 6 require a subcontractor to continue performance if more than forty-five days have elapsed since
- 7 the last day of the month in which such subcontractor furnished labor, materials, services, tools
- 8 or equipment for which such subcontractor has not received payment, shall be void, except to the
- 9 extent such subcontractor has received prior written notice of a good faith dispute regarding the
- 10 quality or quantity of the labor, materials, services, tools or equipment so furnished. This Section
- 11 shall not apply to contracts for public buildings or works.
