#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to a feasibility study of a taxi license database.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be a special commission which shall study the feasibility of a live time database which cross
- 3 references license suspensions through the registry of motor vehicles and taxi driver licenses.
- 4 The commission shall consist of 11 members, 1 of whom shall be appointed by the governor, 1
- 5 of whom shall be the registrar of the registry of motor vehicles or a designee, 1 of whom shall be
- 6 a chief of police appointed by the governor, 3 of whom shall be members of the senate with 2
- 7 being appointed by the senate president and 1 being appointed by the senate minority leader, 3 of
- 8 whom shall be members of the house of representatives with 2 being appointed by the House
- 9 Speaker and 1 being appointed by the house minority leader, 1 of whom shall be the attorney
- 10 general or a designee, and 1 of whom shall be from the Boston Taxi Drivers Association. The
- 11 commission shall make its report and recommendations together with legislation to implement
- 12 those recommendations by filing the same with the clerks of the Senate and House not later than
- 13 July 31, 2016.
