AN ACT RELATIVE TO ACCOMMODATIONS FOR SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENTS TAKING THE MCAS EXAMINATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The fourth paragraph of section 1I of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “needs”, in line 47, the following words:— and such
- 3 children shall be afforded the same accommodation each uses or requires in the classroom throughout the year.
