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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act relative to postpartum depression screening.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 10H the following: -

3           Section 10I. The division shall provide coverage of screenings by pediatricians for  
4 postpartum depression in mothers of newly born children during any visit to a pediatrician’s  
5 office taking place for up to one year from the date of the child’s birth.
