**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act authorizing the town of North Andover to grant an additional liquor license.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of North Andover may grant 1 additional license for the sale of
3 all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of chapter 138 to
4 The Cork Stop, Inc. located at 1593 Osgood Street. The license shall be subject to all of said
5 chapter 138 except said section 17.

6 The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location
7 but it may grant a license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the
8 licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue and a letter from the department of
9 unemployment assistance indicating that the license is in good standing with those departments
10 and that all applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been paid.

11 If a license granted pursuant to this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use at the
12 location of original issuance, the license shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights,
13 privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority and the licensing

14 authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location under the same
15 conditions as specified in this act.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
