#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Philippe Fauche, an employee of the Department of Mental Health.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
department of mental health shall establish a sick leave bank for Philippe Fauche, an employee
of the department of mental health. Any employee of the department of mental health may
voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by

- 5 Philippe Fauche. Whenever Philippe Fauche terminates employment with the trial court or
- 6 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be
- 7 transferred to the trial court paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences
- 8 unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as
- 9 determined by the department of mental health.
