An Act authorizing the town of Fairhaven to grant an additional license for the sale of wines and malt beverages to be drunk on the premises..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws,  
2 the licensing authority of the Town of Fairhaven may issue one additional license for the sale of  
3 wine and malt beverages to be drunk on the premises, pursuant to section 12 of chapter 138 to  
4 Lady J's, Inc., d/b/a Griddles, 140 Huttleston Avenue in the Town of Fairhaven. The license shall  
5 be subject to all of said chapter 138, except said section 17.

6 The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location but it  
7 may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the  
8 licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue indicating that the license is in good  
9 standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

- 10 If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall be
- 11 returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to
- 12 the licensing authority which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location
- 13 under the same conditions as specified in this act.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
