An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Anne Fiesinger, an employee of the Department of Conservation and Recreation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the 2 contrary, the Department of Conservation and Recreation shall establish a sick leave bank for 3 Anne Fiesinger, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may 4 voluntarily contribute to Anne Fiesinger 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick 5 leave bank for use by Anne Fiesinger in the care of her parents. Whenever Anne Fiesinger 6 terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any 7 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick 8 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that 9 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
