## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to vendor contracts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 11 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “commonwealth.”, in line 69, the  
3 following sentence:- Said access shall include access as defined above, to any grant, contract or  
4 agreement between said vendors and any other entity, provided the grant or contract is to provide  
5 services related to, and funded by, the vendor’s contract with the commonwealth, or to provide  
6 goods directly and specifically related to, and funded by, the vendor’s contract with the  
7 commonwealth.

8 SECTION 2. Said section 12 of said chapter 11 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
9 further amended by inserting after the word “section.”, in line 72, the following sentence:- In  
10 addition, any grant, contract or agreement between said vendors and any other entity providing  
11 services to said vendors, provided the grant or contract is to provide services related to, and

12 funded by, the vendor's contract with the commonwealth, or to provide goods to said vendor that  
13 are directly and specifically related to a vendor's contract with the commonwealth, the funding  
14 for said goods being the vendor's contract with the commonwealth, shall include a clause  
15 providing the state auditor with access to said other entity's accounts, books, records and  
16 activities, except tax returns, related to provision of such services or goods to the vendor.
