An Act relative to the Disclosure of Information about Vital Statistics; Conditions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2A of Chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting the following language after section 2A:

3 2A(1): Examinations of records and returns of children born to parents who are married  
4 at the time of birth shall not be permitted except upon the showing of proper identification such  
5 as a valid driver’s license or valid passport. The Town Clerk or appropriate municipal officer  
6 shall keep a record of who has requested a vital record.
