Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15LLLLLL
- 2 the
- 3 following section:-
- 4 Section 15MMMMMM. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
- 5 the month of September as Polycystic Ovary Syndrome Awareness Month to increase citizens'
- 6 awareness of the most common endocrine (hormone) disorder in women, in order to lead to
- 7 better education and thus earlier diagnoses, intervention and care. The proclamation shall
- 8 recommend that the month of September be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
