In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to penalties for operating a motor vehicle under the influence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Subparagraph (1) of paragraph (f) of subdivision (1) of section 24 of
2	chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3	inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:-
4	Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph to the contrary, a person with a previous
5	conviction under this section whose license or right to operate is suspended for 3 years for
6	refusal to submit to a chemical test or analysis of the person's breath or blood may, after the
7	expiration of 1 year of such suspension or during the pendency of any appeal having merits,
8	apply for and shall be granted a hearing before the registrar for the purpose of requesting the
9	issuance of a new license for employment or educational purposes which license shall be
10	effective for not more than an identical 12 hour period every day on grounds of hardship.

- 11 SECTION 2. Said section 24 of said chapter 90 is hereby further amended by inserting
- 12 after the word "permits", in line 621, as so appearing, the following words:-, except as otherwise
- 13 provided in this subparagraph,
