An Act relative to the social host statute .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 34 of Chapter 138, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby

2 amended by inserting after the word "both" in line17, the following words :-

3 and shall be liable in a civil action for all monetary damages arising out of personal injuries and

4 deaths (including personal injury or death to the underage person to whom alcohol was illegally

5 delivered or furnished), or property damages proximately caused by the conduct prohibited

6 herein. In any civil action brought on the basis of this statute, the conduct of the underage person

7 in consuming alcohol delivered to a person in violation of this statute shall not be a defense to

8 the claim whether stated as negligence, comparative fault, intervening or superceding cause, or

9 otherwise.

10 The amendments to this statute shall apply retroactively to all civil actions pending at the time of11 enactment.
